

STUDENTS FEEDBACK:
















INTERPRETATION:

• According to the report, students are satisfied with the design and delivery of their course programme. However, other students stated that the syllabi of the courses in


- which they are enrolled, particularly the mainstream subjects, should be revised on a regular basis.

- Students are pleased with the college's overall academic environment.


TEACHERS' FEEDBACK
























INTERPRETATION:


- The majority of teachers (81.6%) agreed that the curriculum design of their courses is need base in line with the current situation. Maximum teachers agreed that the curriculum should be changed on a regular basis.
- The majority of professors (78.1%) are also pleased with the college's library resources and other infrastructure facilities. They agreed that books available in the Library are need base according to Syllabus.
- Majority (60.1%) of the teachers agreed that the curriculum design of their respective courses is in line with the current scenario. Nevertheless, teachers also expressed that the curriculum needs to be updated periodically.
- Majority of the teachers are also satisfied with the library resources and other infrastructure facilities available in the college. However, they also opined the need for routine and regular maintenance for improving efficiency
- The teacher also made some excellent suggestions for enhancing the college Library, which have been noted for future action.


PARENTS' FEEDBACK
















INFERENCE

- Majority (44.3%) of the parents stated that wards of the students are improving their knowledge the curriculum design of their respective courses is in line with the current scenario. Nevertheless, teachers also expressed that the curriculum needs to be updated periodically. Teachers do not have much freedom to revise/modify the syllabi of their courses as the college follows the curriculum only approved by the affiliating University, Manipur University.
- Majority of the teachers are also satisfied with the library resources and other infrastructure facilities available in the college. However, they also opined the need for routine and regular maintenance for improving efficiency
- Teacher also provided several valuable suggestions for improving the college and these have noted for necessary action.

ALUMNAE FEEDBACK

Alumni feedback is essential for overall improvement of the college. Alumni members, registered as well as unregistered, are connected through whatsapp groups and other social networking platforms. Though we received only 60 feedback submissions during the 2020-21 sessions, a majority of them expressed satisfaction with the curriculum, course contents and the teaching methods employed by teachers.














INFERENCE

- It is observed that majority of the alumni members gave positive response to course coverage.
- Even though a majority of them are satisfied with the teaching methods, infrastructure & lab facilities as well as extracurricular activities, there is a mixed response with some expressing their dissatisfaction.
