ABOUT THE SEMINAR

The Two-Day National Seminar on "Cultural Landscape and Tourism in North East India with Special Reference to Manipur" aims to explore the dynamic relationship between culture, environment, and tourism in the region. Grounded in the concept of cultural landscape, the seminar seeks to examine how indigenous knowledge systems, belief practices, livelihoods, and historical experiences shape lived landscapes in North East India. With a special focus on Manipur, the seminar aims to address the opportunities and challenges posed by tourism, including heritage conservation, community participation, and ecological sustainability. The seminar provides an interdisciplinary platform for scholars, researchers, planners, and practitioners to engage in critical discussions on culturally sensitive and sustainable approaches to tourism and heritage management in the region.



CONCEPT NOTE

The concept of cultural landscape, articulated by Carl O. Sauer, provides a critical framework for understanding landscapes as products of continuous interaction between culture and nature. This perspective is particularly relevant to North East India, where indigenous knowledge systems, ritual practices, and historical experiences shape lived landscapes. With Manipur as a special reference, the seminar examines cultural landscapes such as wetlands, agricultural terrains, sacred groves, settlement patterns, and heritage sites in relation to tourism and heritage development. While tourism offers opportunities for cultural visibility and economic sustainability, it also raises concerns of environmental stress and commodification. The seminar promotes interdisciplinary dialogue on sustainable, community-oriented, and culturally sensitive approaches to heritage and tourism management.

- Abstracts should be within **300 words, including 3–5 keywords**.
- Abstracts must clearly indicate the **objective, methodology, and relevance to the seminar theme**.
- Full papers should be between **4,000–6,000 words, including notes and references**.
- Manuscripts must be typed in **Times New Roman, 12-point font, with 1.5 line spacing and standard margins**.
- References should follow a standard **academic citation style (APA/Chicago)**.
- The paper must be **original and unpublished** and should not be under consideration elsewhere.
- Co-authored papers require **separate registration** for each author.
- Selected papers may be considered for publication in an **edited volume/proceedings**, subject to peer review.
